### Sports Premium Proposed Spending Plan 2020 - 2021

#### What is the PE & Sports Premium Funding?

- The funding is provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, and will see money going directly to primary school Headteachers to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children.
- For the 2020 - 2021 academic year, Ridgeway Primary School will receive an allocation IRO **£20,000**
- **The planned use of the Sports Funding will be dependent on school being able to access the use of external visitors and leisure facilities with the restrictions in place due to the COVID pandemic**

<b>Proposed Spending of the 2020 - 2021 Sports Premium Funding</b>	
<b>What we plan to do</b>	<b>Estimated Cost</b>
1. Progressive Sports provide 2 hours per week of high quality sporting provision as part of our Fast Forward enrichment activities. This is provided within the school day so that all children have the opportunity to benefit from it over the course of a school year. It is intended this will take place from the spring term 2021	<b>£2,500</b>
2. Participation in sporting competitions and events through the Burntwood Cooperative Learning Trust facilitated by Progressive Sports	<b>£500</b>
3. The alternative sporting provision which we offer our KS pupils during the spring / summer terms means that all of our children get to experience activities which some wouldn't usually have the opportunity to do. This adds to the cultural capital of our pupils and enables them to learn a new sport and develop new skills.	<b>£8,500</b>
4. The sports funding enables our Y6 pupils to swim for a six week block during the summer term as a the last half term in order to meet the national curriculum requirements for swimming and water safety by the end of primary school.	<b>£500</b>
5. Increased opportunities to access a wide variety of sporting activities through lunch time and after-school sporting;	<b>£1,000</b>
6. Providing a subsidy to enable all pupils to participate in after school sports clubs	<b>£1,000</b>
7. Further contribution to the studio build	<b>£6,000</b>
